

Quick Start Guide - PUP STATIONS

3000 Series WatchDog Pup Stations (All 3200 & 3500 868/900mHz Radio Models)





Unbox your weather station.

Attach antenna and, if applicable, attach anemometer, light sensor, bird guard and/or any external sensor(s).

(For 3230 Models, screw the stand post onto the base plate)

Scan to install Watchdog Mobile on your phone or download from your App Store.





If using a Retriever without a Cellular/WiFi modem, please download RPLU and follow Configuration Instructions on Pages 5-8 of the Retriever and Pups Product Manual.

Check the channel number on retriever. Power up the retriever. If it is not already in SETUP mode (LED flashing AMBER continuously), press and hold its RED button for 2 seconds.

Open the weather station door and slide the power switch to the ON position. Wait 20 seconds for the station to power up.



Turn on the station's Bluetooth by pressing the **SELECT** button. Release the button when LED turns on. LED will then flash continuously for 3 minutes.

Open the Watchdog Mobile app. Click on **BLUETOOTH**.

Select the station's serial # from the list.



Click on the gear @icon which will take you to the configuration page.

Enter the station name. Enter latitude and longitude by clicking **USE MY LOCATION.**

Set the logging intervals. Set the radio channel to the channel used by the Retriever.

Click on **PORTS** tab and verify that all sensors are listed.

If additional sensors are connected, configure them from the drop-down menu.

Once completed, tap the save icon lin the top right corner.



If anemometer-equipped, select the station's serial # from the list again and then click the **OTHER** tab. A button will appear to **SET NORTH**.

Point the wind vane in the north direction and tap **SET** NORTH.

Upon **SUCCESS** tap **OK**.



Weather station is now set. If using a cellular modem with Retrievers, changes should appear in SpecConnect within the next 3 upload intervals.

Press and hold the **RED** button on the Retriever to take it out of SETUP mode.
