## **USER'S GUIDE**

## Item # 3665BG

#### **Contents**

- Plastic ring
- 20 14-gauge, metal spikes [3.75" (9.5cm)]
- 1.75" (4.5cm) screw

### nut

lock washer

#### Setup

- 1. Place the ring assembly on a flat surface such that the holes are facing up. (fig. 1).
- 2. Put a spike in each hole. Push until it cannot be inserted any further. To minimize the chance for injury, the spike should be inserted at a slight angle (fig. 2a) rather than straight down (fig. 2b).
- 3. Loosen the nut/washer on the ring assembly far enough so the ring can easily fit around the rim of the rain collector.
- Wrap the ring around the rim of the rain collector. Leave a gap of about  $\frac{1}{4}$ " ( $\frac{1}{2}$ cm) from the top (fig. 3).
- 5. Hand tighten the screw.
